The undersigned is directed to say that for making the process of enumeration during the ensuing Socio Economic and Caste Census 2011 transparent following steps may be incorporated during field operations. These issues may also be incorporated in the training of functionaries and in the IEC plan/campaign.

2. In case there are differences in the information provided by the respondent and the persons present during the enumeration, the issue may be resolved through discussion.
