A Group was formed in the name of Chari Madhyapara Self-Help Group on 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2000 in

village Chari Uzanpara of Bardamal G.P. under Balijana Dev. Block. The SHG was formed with 10 (ten) female members. Earlier, the members of the SHG were unemployed and had to run their family through economic hardships. As soon as they could know about the concept of SHG under Swarnajayanti GramSwarojgar Yojana (SGSY) from the block staffs and then they called a meeting of the like-minded members and formed the SHG. The SHG decided to save Rs.20.00 per head.

In this way their banking habits were developed. After six months of the formation of SHG, a grading exercise was done by the Block officials and bankers and this group became qualified for getting revolving fund. The S.B.I. Goalpara Branch has sanctioned an amount of Rs.25, 000.00 (Rupees twenty five thousand) as revolving fund against this group in the year 2001 and it strengthened their corpus fund. The Members of the group could take up some minor activities and again, after six months of getting revolving fund, another grading exercise was done by the Block staffs and bankers and this group was qualified as Grade-II. Then this SHG applied for loan against Piggery farming and the Bank sanctioned loan for Rs.1, 93,200.00 (one lakh ninety three thousand and two hundred) in the year 2006. This group constructed houses and necessary infrastructure for piggery farming. The piglets (30 nos.) have already been purchased and started rearing. The members of the SHG have already given training on maintenance and

nursing by line department. At present, the group is successfully running the firm and also regularly repaying the bank loan. The members of the group are successfully generating self-employment through the firm. At present the monthly income of the members of the group is Rs. 1, 000/- (One thousand) per head, and it is expected to rise up to Rs. 3, 000/- (Three Thousand) in the next year.

The firm has been proved to be a positive and successful step for the members of the Chari Uzanpara SHG towards generating self employment and regular income.

The above group was formed in the name of Bhalukdubi Borpara Sanchay Puji on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2000 in village Bhalukdubi Barpara of Kalyanpur G.P. under Balijana Dev. Block. The SHG was formed with 15 (fifteen) female members. Earlier, the members of the SHG were unemployed and had to run their family through economic hardships. As soon as they could know about the concept of SHG under Swarnajayanti Gram Swarajgar Yojana (SGSY), then they called a meeting of the like minded members and formed the SHG. The SHG decided to save Rs.25.00 per head.

In this way their banking habits were developed. After six months of the formation of SHG, a grading exercise was done by the Block officials and bankers. This group became qualified for getting revolving fund. The AGV, Bank Goalpara Branch has sanction an amount of Rs.25,000.00 (Rupees twenty five thousand) as revolving fund against this group in the year 2001 and it strengthened their corpus fund. The Members of the group could take up some minor activities and after six months of getting revolving fund, the 2<sup>nd</sup> grading exercise was done by the Block staffs and bankers and this group was qualified. Then this SHG applied for loan against Weaving and the Bank sanctioned a subsidy loan for Rs.1, 52,820.00 (one lakh fifty two thousand eight hundred and twenty) on Weaving scheme in the year 2004. This group constructed weaving-shed and necessary infrastructure for regular weaving. The members of the SHG have already given skill up gradation training on quality weaving by line departments, and Balijana Anchalik Janaseva Samitee. At present, the group is successfully running the weaving

industry and also regularly repaying the bank loan in installments. The members of the group are successfully generating self-employment through the weaving industry. The group participated at SHARAS at Guwahati last year. At present the monthly income of the members of the group is Rs1, 000/- (One thousand) per head, and it is expected to rise up to Rs 3, 000/- (Three Thousand) in the next year.

The weaving industry has been proved to be a positive and successful step for the members of the Borpara Mahila Sanchay Puji SHG towards generating self-employment and regular income.

The **Milon SHG** was formed on 23/11/2001 by 12 female BPL members of village Maju Borgum area of Damra G.P. under Kushdhowa T.D. Block. They open S/B Account No. 4084/14 in AGV, Bank, Dudhnoi Branch on 13/11/2002. The C/C loan was sanctioned Rs. 25,000/- (RF Rs. 10,000) to the group by Bank. They took up weaving as economic activity and started selling the products of weaving like Mekhela-Sadar, Gamosa, Dakbandha (Garo Dress), Shirt, Frok, Plastic Doll, woolen clothes etc. in Dudhnoi, Krishnai and Meghalaya areas. There by they increase their corpus fund Amount up to Rs. 60,000/- (Sixty thousand).

Then they passed the II (2<sup>nd</sup>) grading and an Amount of Rs. 1,52,820/- was sanction on 7/10/2005. They expanded their activities and also engaged three another BPL women labour for the near by villages. Thus their group has increased their standard of living and also help the labours of other BPL families. The recovery of the group is satisfactory. The annual income of each member of the SHG is Rs. 26,400/- (Twenty six thousand four hundred) only per year. The group also replay their loan installments regularly and it seems that the members of SHG's are fully self employed.

They open S/B Account No. 15077/79 in Uco Bank Dudhnoi Branch on 2/09/2004. The C/C loan was sanctioned Rs. 25,000/- (RF Rs. 10,000) to the group by Bank and thus the group expanded their corpus fund after passing the grade-II stage the Bank has sanctioned subsidy loan amounted to Rs. 2,75,000/- on dairy scheme. They started selling the products like Milk, Ghee, Butter etc. in Dudhnoi, Krishnai and Meghalaya areas. Their by they increases their income. They

Greenland SHG was formed with 10 Nos. of unemployed educated youths of village Sidhabari from BPL families under the leadership of Sri Chittaranjan Kalita as per SGSY guideline on 28-8-2003. The SHG members have decided to contribute @ Rs. 50/- per head per month. After collection of contribution from all the members of the SHG, they deposited the money in their Group S.B. Account opened by the SHG earlier at AVG Bank, Matia Branch.

They maintained related documents of the SHG properly, and with time barking habit gawn with the members of the society.

During the month of Aprile'04, a grading exercise was done by the Block and Bank and the group passed Grade-I and the Bank has sanctioned a cash credit loan of Rs. 25,000/- as revolving fund.

During the month of March'2006, the group passing the Grading-II stage and the Bank has sanctioned a loan amounting to Rs. 2,60,000/- on Poultry (Broiler) scheme.

At present the SHG benefited by selling Broilers at different places. They are earning more income and they also returning the loan installment to the Bank regularly. The group also opened a Broiler Feed Shop at Sidhabari Market for use the feeds of their own firm and other

farmers of the areas. Now, each member earning Rs. 1,500/- per month and expected to earn more than Rs. 2,000/- per member per month within a few months.

They open S/B Account No. 2260/8 in AGV, Bank Dubapara Branch. The C/C loan was sanction Rs. 25,000/- (RF Rs. 10,000) to the group by Bank. They took up Patimaking as economic activity and started selling the production of sital pati all over Goalpara District as well as in Guwahati. There by they increase their corpus fund. Then they passed the II (2<sup>nd</sup>) grading and an Amount of Rs. 2,00,000/- was sanction on 21/04/2006 by the Bank. They expanded their activities and also increase their productions and earning more incomes by selling the Sitol Pati and diversified products from Sitol Pati. They also participated in SARAS mela held in the district and out side the district. The SHG has repaid the loan regularly. Now

the income of the SHG is about Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty thousand) per month and gradually the economic condition of the members of SHG are becoming sound.

Name of Scheme - Rearing of C.B. Milch cows (Dairy Firm)



While some youth of the state is hankering after easy money without any productive activities, but the members of the Ashirbad SHG Falimari formed by the Jaleswar Dev. Block have shown a good example for self employment by establishing a Dairy Firm under the SGSY scheme of the Govt.

The Ashirbad SHG comprising 12 Nos swarojgaries formed in the year 2003 by the active support of the officials of the Jaleswar Dev. Block was given revolving fund in the same year after they were imparted awareness training. The swarojgaries were highly motivated for self employment through Dairy enterprise. Under this scheme, this SHG started their economic activities on Dairy farming financed by the UCO Bank, Lakhipur Branch in the year 2005 and they were imparted skill upgradation training. With the scheme value amounting Rs. 2,75,000/- they started dairy farming with 8 (eight) Nos. of high yielding crossbred Jersey cows.

Since inception of the Dairy husbandry the SHG are getting average 40 (forty) litters of Milk and in the Lakhipur area they have augmented the level of milk production. With this noble venture besides increasing Milk production they have opened the eyes of some other to accept this scheme for their livelihood.

Besides, this dairy husbandry practises the swarojgaries, have in the mean time formed one Rindan Samity named "ASHIRBAD RINDAN SAMITY" through which they are also providing loan to the needy people. We have come to know that the individual Swarojgaries are getting monthly average income of Rs. 2000/- Per month. More income is expected in future.

The SHG are in regular repayment of Bank loan and they are fully self employed.

They are making good rapport with the Vety. department, Dev. block and the Bank. Presently the firm is having the total strength of animals 12 Nos of cows with calves.

It is hoped the SHG will be successful.
