NATIONAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR PROCUREMENT OF GCI SHEET.

Section -I

The Commissioner, Panchayat & Rural Development, Assam, India invites sealed tender affixing Court fee stamp of Rs.8.25 on the bid from reputed GCI sheet manufacturing companies/authorized dealers for supply of the following materials.

1. Brief Description of the materials to be supplied with technical specification :
Name of the item: Galvanized Corrugated Iron sheet (GCI sheet)

Specification:

- i) **GCI sheet should be ISI marked (IS: 277:2003 and latest amendment if any, class –VIII, Grade of coating of Zinc : 120**
- ii) **Dimension after corrugation :
2500mm X 810mm X 0.4 mm, minor variation upto 2% in length and breath will be allowed and variation in thickness and Zinc coating can be considered to the tune of IS specification/tolerance.**
- iii) **Tolerance in dimension should be as per relevant IS specification.**

2. The approximate value of work will be either **Rs. 41.00 (Forty one) Crores or Rs. 110.00 (One hundred and ten) Crores. The bidders will fill up 2 (Two) rates separately in Price Schedule-I and Price Schedule-II** for two different amounts of supply.

3. **Eligibility of bidder:** Any reputed GCI sheet manufacturing company/Authorized dealer having ISI standard certification with above mentioned specification may submit tender along with following documents:

- i. The bidder should submit a copy of their company registration certificate with permit for manufacturing/trading the above specified GCI sheet with trade license/excise registration.
- ii. The bidder should have a network of dealer in the state of Assam for delivery of GCI sheet in all the 219 blocks.
- iii. The annual turnover of the bidder should be minimum Rs. 50 crore (average) during last 3 years in the state of Assam.
- iv. CA audit report for last 3 years must be submitted.
- v. The bidder must have income tax/ PAN card and sales tax /VAT clearance certificate.
- vi. Performance statement for last 3 years as per section IV.
- vii. The bid must be submitted by the bidder who is either manufacturer of authorized dealer of a specific manufacturer. In case of authorized dealer, he must submit authorization form as given at Section III.

4. General condition of contract:

- i. A complete set of bidding documents may be purchased by an interested eligible bidder on submission of a written application to the Commissioner, Panchayat & Rural Development, Assam and upon payment of a non refundable fee of Rs. 1000.00 (Rupees One Thousand Only) in the form of cash/demand draft in favour of the Commissioner, Panchayat & Rural Development, Assam payable at SBI Dispur branch, Guwahati (Branch Code: 3030). Interested bidder may also download the documents from the official website www.pnrassam.nic.in and in such cases the bidders will have to deposit non refundable fee of Rs. 1000.00 (Rs. One thousand only) as tender cost along with the tender in the form of bank draft.
- ii. The Bidders will have to submit the bid documents in a sealed envelop. The envelop should contain all bid documents with terms and conditions and bid security of Rs. 40 lakh in the form of Bank draft. Each bidder whose tender is accepted will have to furnish a performance guarantee at the rate of 5% of work value by way of bank draft payable at Guwahati before issue of work order. **Bid security and performance guarantee can also be submitted in the form of fixed deposit/bank guarantee, over and above in demand draft form.**
- iii. Validity period should be minimum 6 months.
- iv. The bidder should submit trade license and registration certificate from appropriate authority with capacity of manufacturing/Supplying the items.
- v. The rates for the items should be quoted per Metric Ton (MT) inclusive of all taxes and carriage charge with loading and unloading at flat rate for all the 219 blocks of

the state as per Section II of the bid document. **(Price Schedule-I and Price Schedule-II)**

- vi. The tenderer should indicate the number of GCI sheet per Metric Ton (MT) of the specifications **in the appropriate column of the price schedule.**
- vii. **There will be inscription on each piece of GCI sheet as per the requirement of the purchaser.**
- viii. Quality certificate for each consignment should be attached along with the bills for payment. Factory inspection will be conducted by authorized officers from the department. It may be on monthly basis. If required third party inspection may also be resorted to. Necessary expenses for the same will be borne by the purchaser i.e. Commissioner, P&RD, Assam.
- ix. **The materials will be delivered at blocks and the bills will be paid by the Project Directors, DRDAs. Necessary funds as per district wise target will be released to the Project Director DRDAs. Project Director DRDAs will make the payment to the supplier after delivery of the materials.**
- x. The purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any or all of the tenders without assigning any reason thereof and is not bound to accept the lowest quoted rate.
- xi. Packaging of materials is to be done as per instruction of the purchaser.

5. **Special conditions of the contract:**

- i. The rates should be quoted both in words and figures specifying the actual value of the materials, taxes and carriages with loading and unloading to destination separately as per price schedule given at Section II, **in both Price Schedule-I and Price Schedule-II. The bidder will fill up 2 (Two) rates in price schedule given at section II, Price Schedule-I and Price Schedule-II. If the quantity is finally fixed at approximately Rs. 41.00 (Forty one) Crores, rates in Price Schedule-I will apply and if the quantity is finally fixed at approximately Rs. 110.00 (One hundred and ten) Crores, rates in Price Schedule-II will apply.**
- ii. The matter of "C" Form required for the manufacturer of the other states will have to be taken up by the bidders with the taxation department and "C" Form will not be provided by the P & RD department. **Road Permit also would not be issued by the purchaser.**
- iii. The time of completion of work is **2 (Two) months** from the date of issue of the work order. For any delay beyond **3 (Three) months** from the date of issue of work order penalty will be imposed as given below:
 - a. For 1 to 30 days : - 2% of the work value of balance quantity.
 - b. For 31 to 60 days: - 4% of the work value of balance quantity.
 - c. For 61 to 90 days: - 6% of the work value of balance quantity.
 - d. Beyond 90 days the work order will be cancelled and security deposit will be liable to be forfeited.
- iv. **The bidder should mobilize adequate resources for timely completion of the work order. If delivery does not start within a reasonable time from the date of work order and does not continue uninterruptedly the purchaser will have the right to cancel the work order. Moreover, regular and continuous supply must be ensured throughout the period of completion of work.**
- v. One Agreement Deed will have to be executed by the bidders before issue of work order mentioning the terms and condition of the tender.
- vi. **The supply order can be divided between two bidder at L₁ rate for quick completion of supply. L₁ bidder will get work order for atleast 50% quantity and L₂ bidder can be given the rest quantity of 50% at L₁ rate. If L₂ bidder refuses to execute the work order at L₁ rate, then the same can be given to L₃ bidder at L₁ rate and so on.**
